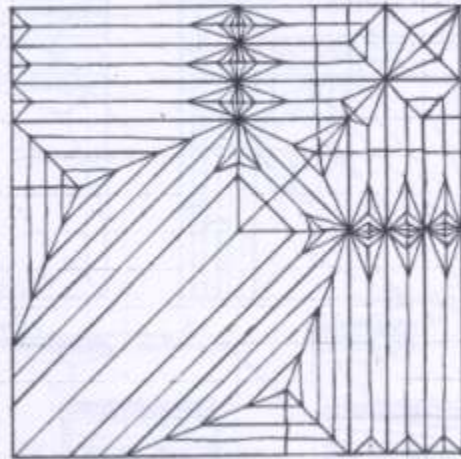

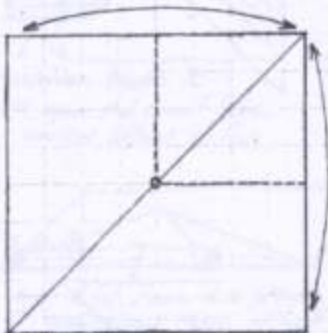

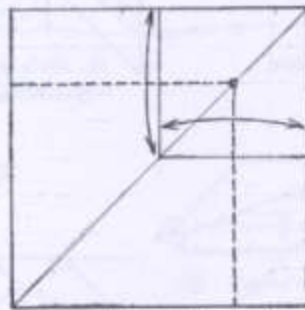
crease pattern



folded size



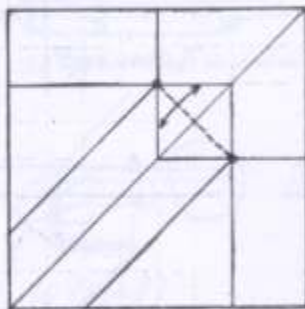
1. Valley folds to the diagonal.
(color-side up).



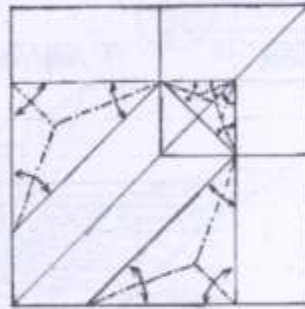
2. Crease the width, to the diagonal.



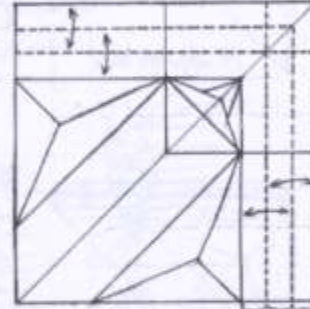
